How to play.

1. Cut out each team's name, fold them in half and then put them into a hat or a container for participants to select their entry.
2. You can charge as much as you like per entry. With 32 competing teams one suggestion would be to charge £2 per team which would raise £64 for ActionAid.
3. Get your friends/colleagues to draw a team name. Write down who drew which team on the sweepstake poster and display on your wall or noticeboard.
4. Make sure you manage to sell all of the teams! It's usually a good idea to keep the teams that have already been picked a secret until all the teams have been sold.
5. See if you can get a prize donated or use £10 of the total raised. After the World Cup has been won, present the winner with their prize!
