You've said women's rights will be at the heart of your HIV and AIDS strategy.

This Valentine's Day show me how much you care. Ensure your new strategy can deliver real benefits for women affected by HIV and AIDS across the world.

Say you will

Include clear targets on women's rights in the strategy. These should include

- ♥ training for health care and service providers to recognize and respond to symptoms of violence as a routine part of HIV related care
- ♥ more funding for women-friendly health services that integrate HIV and sexual and reproductive healthcare
- ♥ provision and support of mobile drug distribution and treatment points to help women access and adhere to HIV treatment
- ♥ more funding for female-controlled HIV prevention methods including microbicides and female condoms
- ♥ greater involvement of women's movements – especially women living with HIV and AIDS – in setting, implementing and monitoring policies that affect them

Set out ways to measure DFID's success in meeting these targets. These should include indicators that measure

- ♥ the percentage of health providers trained in responding to violence
- ♥ the number of adults and children on antiretroviral treatment disaggregated by gender
- ♥ women's adherence to ART
- ♥ the availability of female condoms

Make sure that the promises contained in the strategy are backed up with genuine commitment across DFID.
