Aboutthe Arise Fund

When a woman is placed at the centre of emergency response, she rebuilds more than just buildings. We know that when women are in positions of leadership, they contribute to better preparation for emergencies, more effective emergency responses and lasting peace building.

ActionAid's Arise Fund was established to bring more women into key leadership positions. It is the first ever global fund for women's leadership in emergency response and preparedness.

The goal of the Fund is long-term transformation: turning traditional crisis response on its head by putting women at its heart.

The three core aims of the Arise Fund are:

- 1. to **train** and **empower** more women around the globe to become leaders in disaster preparedness in their communities,
- 2. to ensure women's **rights** are protected during crises, and
- 3. to build women's **resilience** so they can face the challenges and respond better to future disasters.

Over the next ten years, the ambitious goal of ActionAid's Arise Fund is to raise £5 million to reach two million people around the world through womenled humanitarian assistance.

Impact

of ActionAid's emergency response

ActionAid has a strong track record of emergency response, and we know that our approach works. Since 1974 we have responded to emergencies – from natural disasters and disease outbreaks to conflicts and refugee crises – saving lives and protecting rights in more than 40 countries.





Haiti

When a 7.2 magnitude earthquake struck southwestern Haiti in August 2021, ActionAid Haiti's response was led by women, including our network of women trained as first responders during emergencies.

Their work has included distributing essential food supplies, cash and tools to clear roads and debris, providing psychosocial support, carrying out awareness raising, and training 20 women leaders and local authorities on the Core Humanitarian Standards and safeguarding, to share this knowledge with community members.

Somaliland

During the food crisis in the Horn of Africa in 2017, ActionAid supported women in the autonomous region of Somaliland to lead in providing urgent relief through distributions of food and clean water to 2,250 people.

The community reported that putting women in charge of distribution created greater trust, and ensured vital items got through to the people who needed them most.

Worldwide

In 2020 we reached 1.2 million people with our emergency responses around the globe (pictured left, in Mumbai, India). The world is facing a series of challenges, from climate change to political instability and the Covid-19 pandemic, so we need to ramp up our efforts in response. This is why we have set ourselves the ambitious target of reaching two million people with women-led action through the Arise Fund.


