Today your child will be learning about the world's biggest rainforest and enjoying fun activities, using their imagination and things you already have at home. Here are some tips to make it easy and fun for you, too.

ACTIVITY 1: CAN YOU SAY...?

What you'll need: paper (or you can print the activity sheet if you have a printer) and a pencil or pen to write your answers.

Answers: How are you? = Como você está, Family = Família, Me = Eu, Please = Por favor, Thank you = Obrigado, Bye = Tchau

You could use a translation website to find the correct pronunciations.



Changing the world with women and girls in Brazil

On this Discovery Day your child will meet Joana, one of the many children ActionAid is working with in Brazil.

In this country where the gap between rich and poor is wide, we teach women and girls about their rights to basic services such as healthcare, clean water and education.

ACTIVITY 2: FIND A FOREST!

What you'll need: items from around your home (or garden, if you have one), space to lay them all out.

You could suggest your child looks for items that could represent trees, vines, flowers, fruit, nuts, animals, rivers! Afterwards, ask them what they chose to use and why.

ACTIVITY 3: WHICH ANIMAL ARE YOU?

What you'll need: a pencil or pen, and paper.

For this activity, we've suggested your child writes a story from the perspective of an animal. This should test their imagination!

ACTIVITY 4: PLANET PROTECTOR!

What you'll need: paper or cardboard to draw on, crayons, colouring pens or poster paints.

This activity lets your child bring together all they've discovered today. If you need to explain what 'climate' means, you could say it's our world's general temperature and weather. They can use any art materials you have to hand to make their poster.
