

Activity - What is the rainforest like?

This activity enables pupils to begin labelling photos with geographical terms. Pupils cut out the clouds and then match them with photos from the Rainforest photos PowerPoint. An extension activity encourages them to imagine what they might see, hear, smell and feel in the rainforest and use their ideas to write a poem.

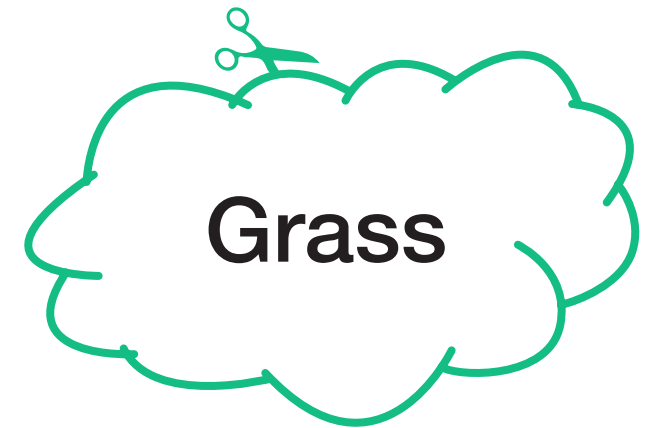
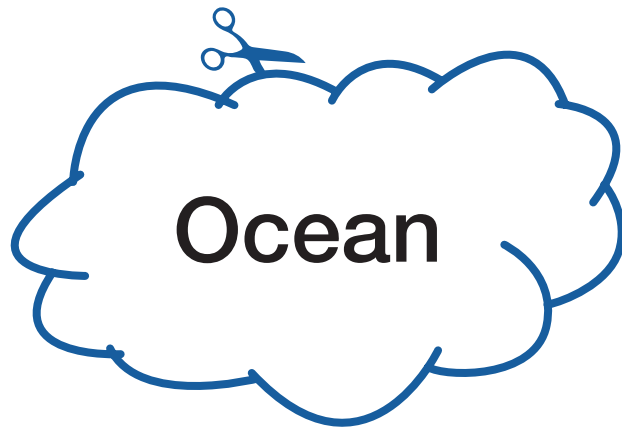
